Reason for change



OUTSIDE IN - our reputation is significantly affected by our ability to commit to a published timetable


- Student NPS score points to unstable and inflexible timetabling and students' volunteer timetabling as an issue they want resolved
- Students need a clash free timetable so they can navigate programme pathways
- Students want contemporary learning with self service dashboard options

INSIDE OUT - we need to use our assets more effectively to deliver a student experience that helps them succeed in life while keeping United relevant

- Utilisation of our space and academic resource
- Streamlined approach to timetable planning with standard processes – data carries over yearly timetabling


Business & Timetable team

 Three test schedules over five weeks

- We are testing the schedules not producing actual timetables. This is a systems and data accuracy test – we're not ready for work planning or making teaching and learning arrangements.
- The testing will help us see how the new automated system deals with assigning days, times and venues for courses and classes.
- There will be errors, conflicts and things that just don't make sense. That's why we're testing!

	Check item	Is this check item fulfilled? (Yes or no; if no, what is the problem?)
1	Courses are scheduled in the correct weeks	
2	Courses are scheduled into an appropriate venue with right fixed equipment and layout	
3	Courses are scheduled with the correct teaching staff	
4	Courses are scheduled at an appropriate day and time	
5	Courses are scheduled for the correct duration	
6	Teaching staff do not have timetable clashes on their teaching timetables	
7	Students do not have timetable clashes on their timetables	
8	Course activities are scheduled in the correct sequence	
9	Teaching staff with any required class-free days are accommodated	
1 0	Teaching staff and students have their lunch breaks as required	
1	Other timetabling requirements important to your Network and Practice Pathway
