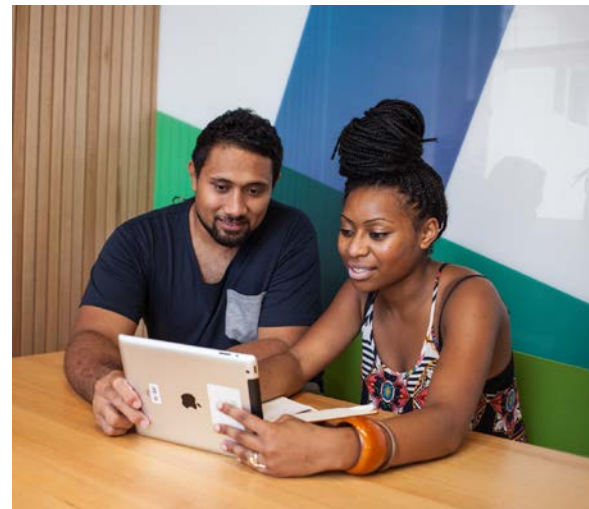
- Librarians linked to Practice Pathways with a focus on specific subjects
