

Design Lecturer **Cris de Groot** recently featured on TV3's *The Project*, in a story on child car seats. The segment explores how safe they are, if parents are being 'ripped off' by the cost of a car seat - if 'dearer' means safer and why the expiry date is so important. *The Project* interviews the Head of Testing at Consumer New Zealand and brings in Cris for some expert analysis. Cris assesses the three seats he has been asked to review, talks about how they are each built and their design features, then takes them into Mataaho to create a cross-section so we can get a better idea of what they are made of and what is keeping your child safe.
