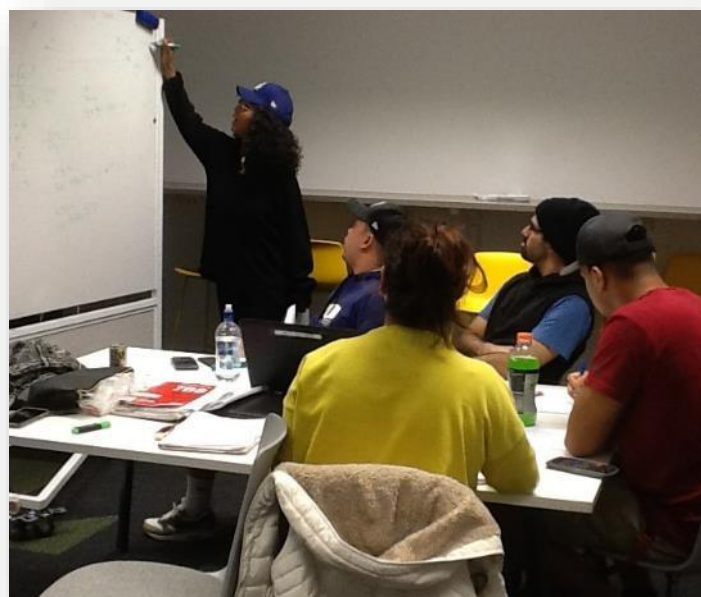

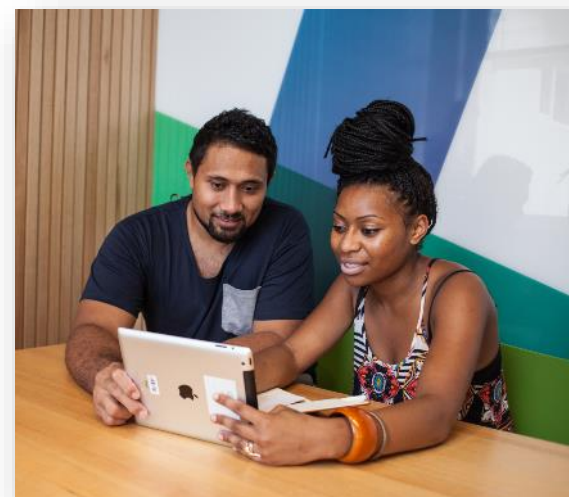



Counselling & Mental Health Support

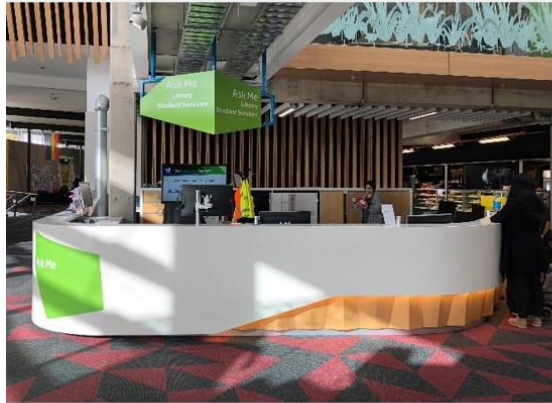
