
# Pacific Success Strategy Operational Plan Dashboard

  - 1.4 Ensure Schools are supported and resourced to take the necessary actions to ensure Pacific students are supported appropriately and succeeding in their studies.









2.5 Grow Pacific staff numbers to reflect the Pacific student population at Unitec as well as the growing Pacific population of the wider Auckland community.




