Purpose

To provide an update to the Commissioner on the activities of the STAR Ropu.

Key Points

- A number of staff provided feedback through STAR members to inform the RoVE submission
- STAR provided feedback to the Commissioner on the RoVE TEC visit
- Met with the Advisory Committee members in April
- Discussed and proposed to ELT that a universal lunch hour be established
- Developed and refined a priority list to focus STAR attention and established tracking of activities and outcomes
- Received the Pulse Survey results at the May meeting and provided ELT with feedback into ways of sharing the results that make it meaningful to staff
- Simon Nash – Director, Ako and Simon Tries, Manager, Te Korowai Kahurangi (TKK) presented on the work being undertaken in TKK. Discussed ways to improve connectivity and communications with staff
- Vivienne Merito and David Glover presented the new marketing strategy which, on recommendation from STAR, resulted in an institute-wide programme of delivery of the strategy
- Simon Tries - merging the two Academic Administrators and Academic Quality Administrators – provided feedback and shared with wider group of staff across the institute
- SeATS discussion – provided feedback into areas of concern to staff, gained insights into what was being looked at from an whole of institute perspective and provided input into areas of priority
- Provided staff feedback into appointment process of Academic Leaders/Academic Programme Managers and received ELT feedback.
