Key Points

- A number of staff provided feedback through STAR members to inform the RoVE submission
- STAR provided feedback to the Commissioner on the RoVE TEC visit
- Met with the Advisory Committee members in April
- Discussed and proposed to ELT that a universal lunch hour be established
- Developed and refined a priority list to focus STAR attention and established tracking of activities and outcomes
- Received the Pulse Survey results at the May meeting and provided ELT with feedback into ways of sharing the results that make it meaningful to staff
- Simon Nash Director, Ako and Simon Tries, Manager, Te Korowai Kahurangi (TKK)
 presented on the work being undertaken in TKK. Discussed ways to improve
 connectivity and communications with staff
- Vivienne Merito and David Glover presented the new marketing strategy which, on recommendation from STAR, resulted in an institute-wide programme of delivery of the strategy
- Simon Tries merging the two Academic Administrators and Academic Quality
 Administrators provided feedback and shared with wider group of staff across the institute
- SeATS discussion provided feedback into areas of concern to staff, gained insights into what was being looked at from an whole of institute perspective and provided input into areas of priority
