United Terms of Reference

Staff Teams Advisory Ropū (STAR)

1. OVERALL PURPOSE/OBJECTIVES

Our role is to partner with Unitecs' Executive Leadership Team (ELT) to inform strategic and operational direction to strengthen the 'staff voice' in decision making. The STAR objectives are to:

- Work with Murray Strong and the Commissioners Advisory Group (AdCom)
- Commit to open and transparent dialogue with ELT and AdCom
- Ensure the 'staff voice' informs all decision making
- Provide feedback to staff following STAR meetings
- Champion and support the ELT and AdCom in providing quality education
- Foster collaboration with ELT, AdCom and wider staff
- Provide support to ELT and AdCom by
 - Delivering timely constructive and solutions-focused feedback to ELT and AdCom on recommendations shared with and by the Group
 - Promoting information shared by ELT and AdCom to the United community
 - Constructively discuss with ELT and AdCom issues that reflect the Group's objectives and which do not circumnavigate Unitec's policies and processes
 - Operate proactively and be ideas driven

2. PRINCIPLES OF ENGAGEMENT (POE)

STAR will use Te Noho Kotahitanga values to engage with staff, ELT, AdCom and each other:

- Rangatiratanga Authority and Responsibility
- Wakaritenga Legitimacy
- Kaitiakitanga Guardianship
- Nohotahi Co-operation
- Ngākau Mahaki Respect

3. TERM

STAR is effective from 1st October 2018 and will be reviewed on/or before the 30th April 2019 (Term)

4. MEMBERSHIP

- Membership of STAR will be reviewed at conclusion of the Term.
- A chair will be appointed and that appointment will be reviewed annual
- STAR undertakes to seek counsel from non-members where specialist skills may be required to carry out its objectives.

5. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The members of STAR are collectively committed to achieving the objectives through the POE and individually, acknowledge and agree; they will:

- attend all scheduled meetings or nominate a proxy from within the Group
- champion STAR within United
- promote the sharing of STAR's official channels to staff and peers for communication and information

- be provided with complete, accurate and meaningful information in a timely manner
- be given reasonable time to provide feedback to inform key decisions
- be alerted to potential roadblocks that can impact progress
- commit to open and honest dialogue in fostering communication with ELT and AdCom

6. MEETINGS

- Meetings will be held every three weeks
- If required full group or sub-group meetings will be arranged outside of these times at a time convenient to group members

6. AMENDMENT, MODIFICATION OR VARIATION

This Terms of Reference may be amended, varied or modified in writing after consultation and agreement by STAR at conclusion of the Term
