#### 10.2020 POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP ALLOCATION

 Excel file with 2020 scholarship allocation for Postgraduate Programmes is shared with the committee.



- The committee decided on the following points
  - Separate NZD 40,000 will be allocated from the total amount of NZD 250,000 for both Maori and Pacifica priority groups for the year 2020
  - Separate NZD 11000 will be allocated from the total amount of NZD 250,000 for Bold Innovators Scholarship for the year 2020
  - Separate NZD 3000 will be allocated from the total amount of NZD 250,000 for ITP student w\u00e4nanga at the 2020 symposium for the year 2020
  - Separate NZD 17,000 will be retained from the total amount of NZD 250,000 for industry Scholarship for the year 2020. Tuapapa Rangahau will work with IBM to fund the scholarship on a dollar by dollar basis. Otherwise, Tuapapa Rangahau will contact Director Partnerships to find anther fund provider.
  - Funding for student research dissemination will be included in programme scholarship dissemination plans
- James Prescott and other members supported the allocation of separate funds for priority groups which gives a clear indication that the institute is serious in the development of our priority groups.
- **ACTION:** Leaders of programmes to present a fund allocation plan to the Director of Research & Enterprise in a timely fashion.
- **ACTION:** Assoc Prof Marcus Willaims to check whether international students can be allocated scholarship from PGRSC. The decision will be applicable to the 2021 scholarships.
