Highlights/Achievements

Work with IMT (Incident Management team), support teams and schools on retention of semester 1
 International cohort impacted by travel restrictions – 50% Chinese cohort were offshore at the time of the travel ban. With the right support from schools and the support teams this was reduced to 30% as students made other travel arrangements to New Zealand to continue their studies. The support teams continue to work with students

- Continuing to work on implementing the 4 success strategy priority actions
 - o Implement learner advisor led study groups for internationals
 - Proposal to scale up Construction English for specific purposes course to other programmes with high international numbers
 - Implementing working group on Student progression monitoring opportunities to improve student journey with line of sight to qualification completion.
