Title	PAQC Quarterly Report for April	Date	10 / 04 / 2020

#### Overview

PAQC 2020 memberships (including student rep and senior external staff member) approved at first meeting (Feb 24).

PAQC delegated authorities for 2020 reviewed and finalised. No significant changes to APM roles re admissions, approvals etc. Grades Approval was already in place. PIFs will be reviewed by a new subcommittee of lecturer & APM form programme requesting change, APM from another programme, and PAQC chair or deputy chair. This will probably be by e-meeting, and is done to increase the quality of the PIFs.

#### General Committee Health Check (Each report).

#### What is going well?

Meeting attendance good as PAQC incorporated into the SAB Monday morning sequence, apart from external academic staff who will miss three meetings this year due to teaching. Felt it was worth continuing with (Dr Sofia Chambers) due to existing connection and being in same building.

A student rep has been appointed but yet to attend meetings - may be disrupted through covid19 employment changes.

New agenda layout appears more streamlined

#### What improvements can be made?

PAQC review of PEPs was delayed as none were ready on time (Feb 19). Finally reviewed March 5 at extraordinary meeting. Better support of APMs may help here, although the timing of PEPs will always be an issue. A process of staging the KEQ completion and review is suggested, as is greater pressure on staff to complete CEPs throughout the semester rather than at the end.

Chair felt that a meeting in late January would have been useful in making a good start for 2020, as Feb 24 is day 1 of the semester - too late. Will be arranging this for 2021.

The training for PAQC chairs and members has not been delivered. This is a serious concern as current PAQC membership was recruited on the basis of training being available, and as PAQC appears to be the most important policy and operational forum in the School of Applied Business.

## What support is needed (actions required)?

Still concerned about the high turnover in AAQ supporting the PAQC. Some consistency here would be appreciated. The documents for meetings (agenda, minutes associated docs etc) are too slow in processing, and affect the committee efficiency.



Delivery of training (as below) would also be beneficial.

#### **Training**

#### **PAQC Training**

Work is currently underway to prepare for training for PAQC Chair, Secretaries and Committee members. This training is aimed at enhancing the productivity of the committees and to improve our approach to governance. If you are a member of a committee you will be contacted early in the new year with details about your training session.

#### From a TKK memo dated 28 Feb.

XXXXXXX Lead, Quality Partner will work with each PAQC Chair to complete the initial report. Chairs will receive a report pre-populated by the PAQC secretary for consideration and completion. Further communication about timelines will be communicated via email.

This report is being drafted on April 2 without any of the conditions in the above paragraph being met, (as with the training.)

Noting this in the report, as issues of responsibility and accountability will emerge later in the year, and they will trace back to this point. This is not all due to covid19, but may best be described as a pre-existing condition.

It appears to me from my vantage as PAQC chair that the entire governance function is presently under resourced, and is struggling to meet its obligations. The lead quality partners appear to be over stretched.

### Progress against 3 (max.) key actions (Each report)

No PAQC action plan has been finalised yet. The default action plan is the series of PEP action plans. A review of the SAB component of the AQAP action plan (on Power BI dashboard) shows excellent progress in post grad development work, and zero progress in undergrad which is expected to start in S2, 2020. (HoS is currently doing preparatory work on BBS review).

## Self-evaluation of Governance (March & September)

The constant changing in support staff is preventing development of good practice here, as is the lack of training.

The scope of PAQC as an academic governance function for APM is still undefined, and appears to be increasing – eg risk registers now to be reported on each month (admittedly exceptions only) - to the point that each meeting is unable to complete its agenda in a timely and professional manner.

Individual PAQC (one for each programme), and a separate APM forum is suggested.

Connections of PAQC to QAB, AAC, AA are still weak. Not sure if that matters, but noted.

#### Priorities (3-5) for cycle (March & September)

#### Priorities are

1.Post grad developments (MPA and M Appl. Business.) well underway,



2.Redevelopment of BBS (planned for S2, 2020)

3.Introduction of level 3 and 4 certificates (planned for S1 2021)

## Risk management

Not yet addressed. Planned for May 11 meeting.

## **Quality Reporting**

## **Programme Evaluation (PEP)**

PEPs (EoY2019) completed and actions plans for 2020 underway. No major issues. NZDB5 draft strategic plan (required by NZQA in June2020) in place ad having good effect. Many improvements implemented for start of S1, 2020.

Recently completed (EoY2019) PEP for all programmes were successful in collecting and collating data, but lacking in evaluative practice, partly due to time constraints.

Earlier completion and sharing of CEPs, and staged reviews of PEP drafts is being planned to create more time in the round EoY 2020.
