Highlights/Achievements

- I See Me Initiatives Focus area 5: Improved Code of Practice ADEP overall completion rate from 48% in April to 51% over all teams and continuing to work with Learning and Development team delivering online workshops.
- Success Strategy Priority 1: Slight backward movement for a number of actions due to current workload and Alert level 4 lockdown – unable to deliver student engagement events or continue with development of International NEST pages
- Success Strategy Priorities 2, 3 and 4: Improvement in action progress for priorities 2, 3 and 4 due the collaborative work of the Learning & Development team with scheduling and preparation for Code workshops allowing more time to move the levers on other actions e.g.: Scoping and planning started for the formation of an International reference group.
- **EPI 2022 Targets:** Submission to AB June meeting to approve EPI Targets using linear forecasting based on historical data since 2015. Based on the latest April SDR data and the now updated EPI data for 2019 International students are on track to meet and with FYR already exceeded the 2022 targets (once approved).
