Recommendation/s

That the Committee approve the changes to **AC 2.2 Assessment in Te Reo Māori Procedure** as recommended by the Ako Ahimura Learning and Teaching Committee, effective Semester 2, 2020.

Purpose

A review of **AC 2.2 Assessment in Te Reo Māori Procedure** commenced in late 2019 and was conducted by Sue Crossan, Academic Quality & Capability Partner, & Victor Grbic, Kaihautū, Mātaurangi Maori.

The review involved a process of a number of meetings between Sue Crossan and Victor Grbic to discuss the current Procedure with an aim of making the document clear so that it could be translated into practice more easily. Simon Tries was consulted at various stages. Consultation took place with:
