Recommendation

That the Committee approves the draft Learning & Teaching Strategy

Background

Earlier drafts of this strategy were presented to Ako Ahimura in late 2019 and in May 2020.

The version presented here for approval incorporates feedback on earlier versions.

The format and approach taken in this strategy mirrors that taken in other current strategies, i.e. it is treated as a sub-strategy of *Manaakitia Te Rito*; it is a short document and focused on actionable goals.

As requested by the committee at the meeting of 27 May 2020, the strategy is supported by a document showing success indicators for each objectives and evidence sources. The purpose of this supplementary document is to assure the Committee that the strategy is actionable.

We are seeking approval of the strategy, not the supporting document.

- Learning & Teaching at Unitec: guidelines for teachers and teaching teams (the new pink/orange booklet); fully integrated with Te Tīpare and blended/online learning framework
