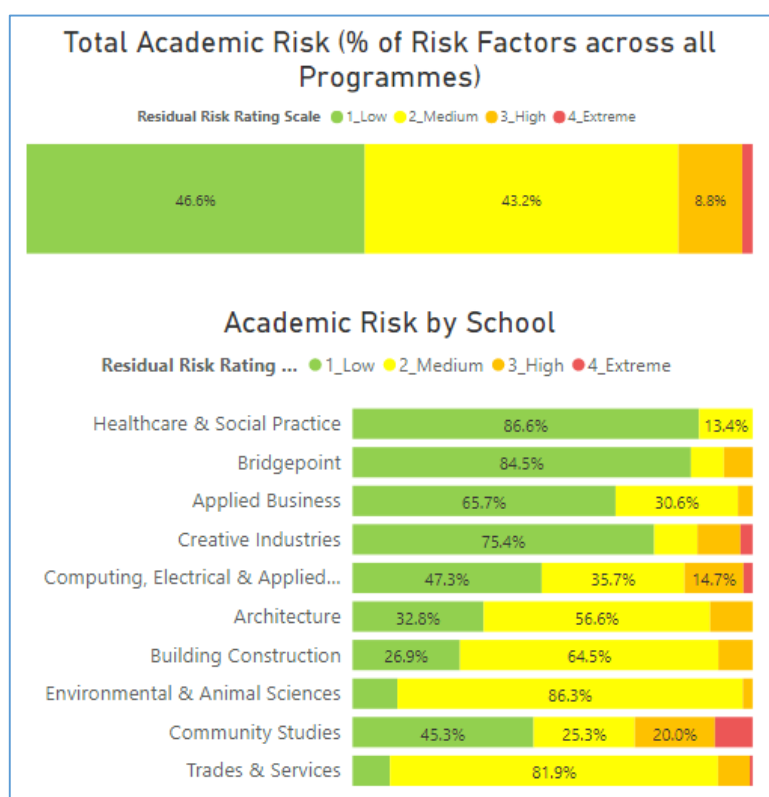


# July 2020 Academic Risk Summary

This report provides data from the 79 programmes that have been rated on 14 risk factors<sup>1</sup> based on updates submitted by APMs on or before 7 July 2020.

## Institutional Risk Summary

The distribution of risk factors across all 79 programmes shows that 46.6% are rated low, an increase of 1.1% compared with the last update in May 2020, while 10.3% are rated either high or extreme which is a slight drop of 0.6%. At the school level, as in the previous updates, risk is low for Creative Industries, Healthcare & Social Practice, Applied Business and Bridgepoint while Community Studies continues to show the highest level of risk.

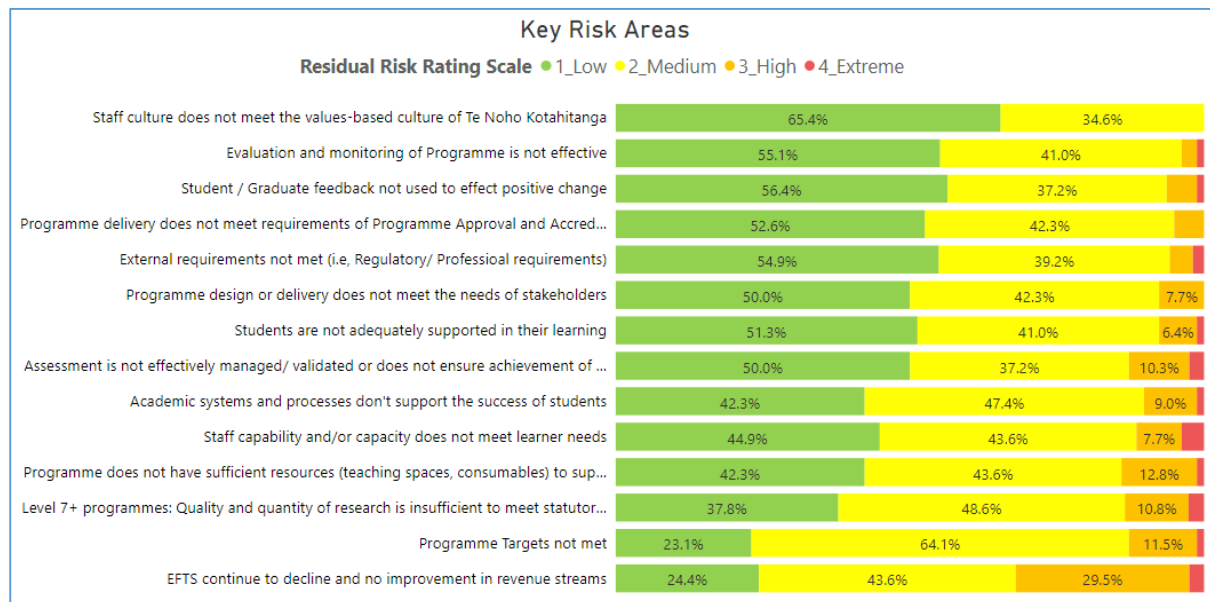


The areas that receive the highest risk ratings across all programmes include:

- External requirements not met (i.e. Regulatory / Professional requirements)
- "Level 7+ programmes: Quality and quantity of research is insufficient to meet statutory requirements and contribute to student success"

1. EFTS continue to decline and no improvement in revenue streams (32.1% rated either high or extreme risk).
2. Programme does not have sufficient resources (teaching spaces, consumables) to support delivery (14.1%).
3. Programme targets not met (12.8%).
4. Assessment is not effectively managed / validated or does not ensure achievement of outcomes (12.8%).

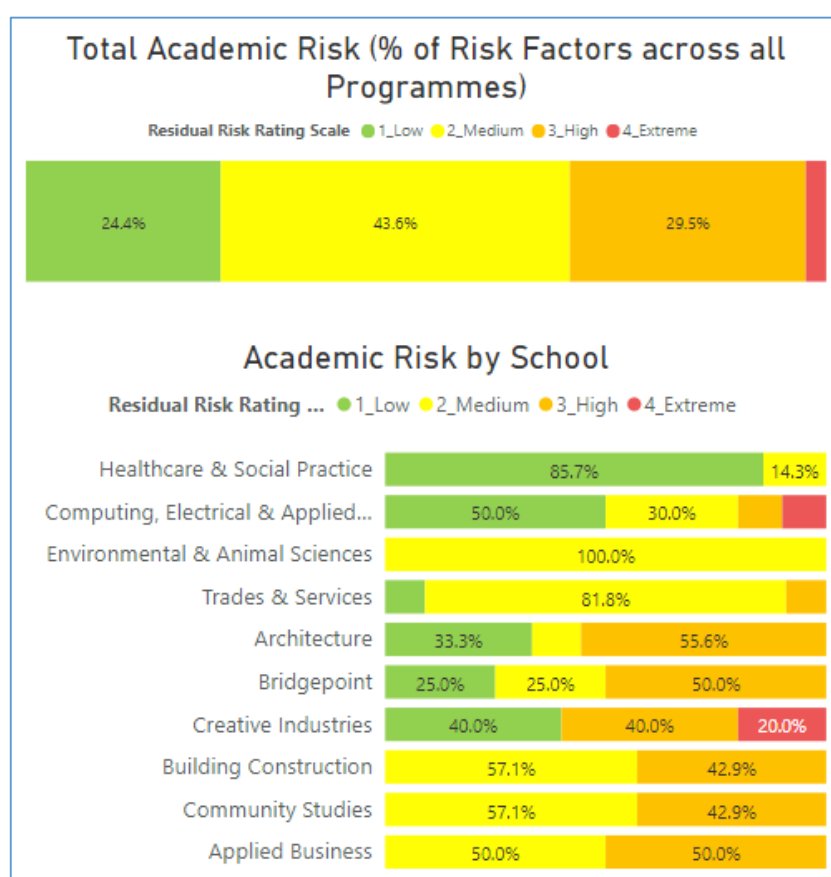

## Key Risk Areas

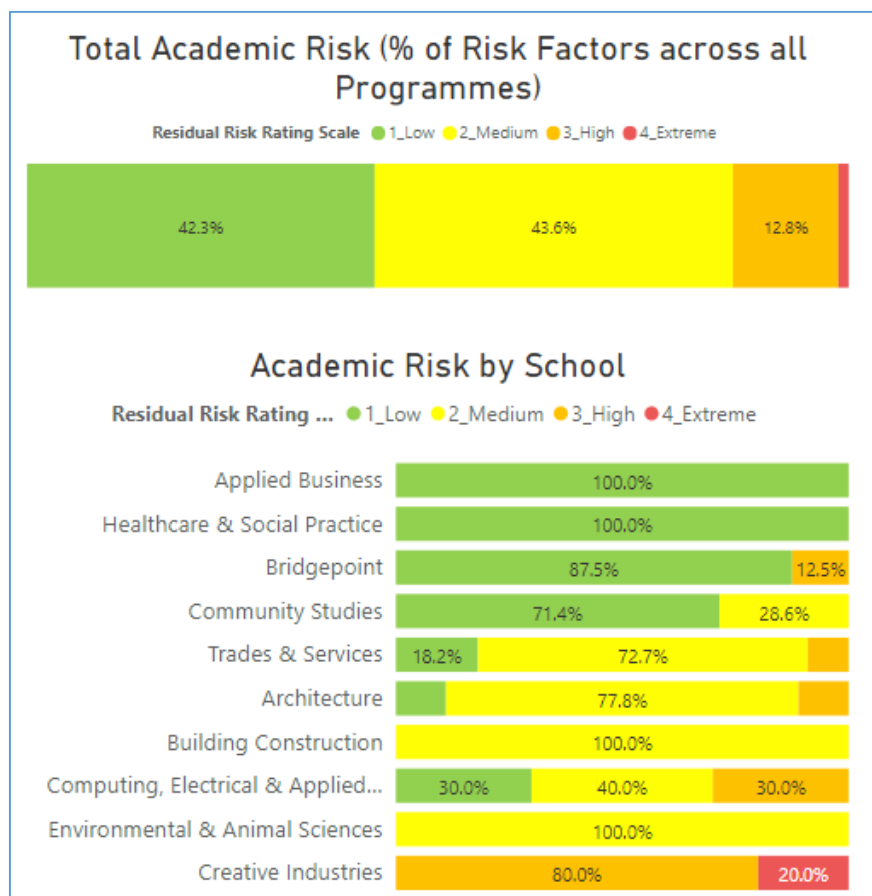
### 1. EFTS continue to decline and no improvement in revenue streams

- 32.1% of all programmes are rated either high or extreme risk, an improvement of 2.6% over the previous update and 5.8% over a 2-month period.
- Schools with particularly high risk include Creative Industries (60%), Architecture (55.6%), Bridgepoint (50%) and Applied Business (50%). The risk decline was mainly driven by Architecture which shows a wholesome improvement of 22.2% over the previous update while the risk level for the other 3 schools remain the same.



## 2. Programme does not have sufficient resources (teaching spaces, consumables) to support delivery

- 14.1% of all programmes are rated either high or extreme risk, with no change over the previous update.
- Creative Industries still shows the greatest risk with 100% of their programmes rated high or extreme in this area.
- Computing, Electrical and Applied Technology continues to have 30% of their programmes being rated high in this area.



## 3. Programme targets not met

- 12.8% of all programmes are rated either high or extreme risk, an improvement of 5.2% over the previous update and 8.7% over a 2-month period.
- Community Studies have replaced Bridgepoint as the school with the greatest risk with 42.9% of their programmes rated high or extreme in this area. Bridgepoint has shown a whopping improvement of 37.5%.

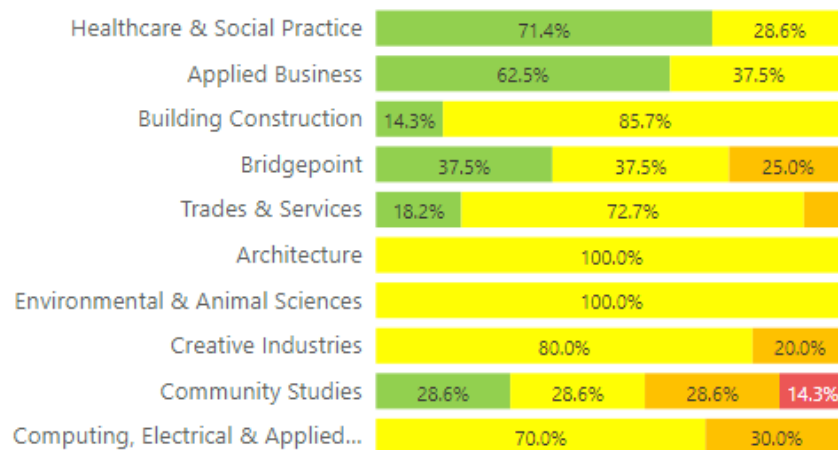
## Total Academic Risk (% of Risk Factors across all Programmes)

Residual Risk Rating Scale ● 1\_Low ● 2\_Medium ● 3\_High ● 4\_Extreme



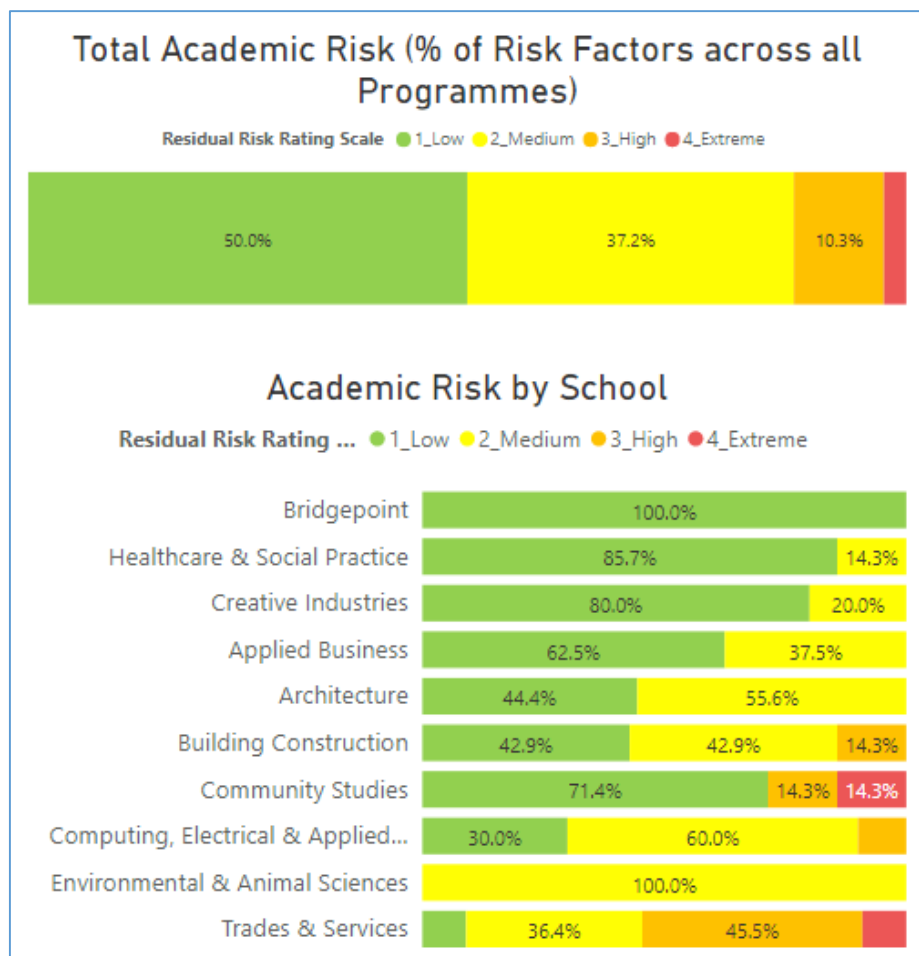
## Academic Risk by School

#### 4. Assessment is not effectively managed / validated or does not ensure achievement of outcomes (12.8%).

- 12.8% of all programmes are rated either high or extreme risk.
- This replaces “Staff capability and/ or capacity does not meet learner needs” (which improves by 1.2%) as the third highest risk factor.
- Trades & Services shows the greatest risk with 54.5% of its programmes rated in high or extreme risk in this area.
