I have cc'd in Catrin who we work with in regards to all the other Secondary Tertiary MOU's as she will be able to walk you through the process (Catrin VP ones will be with you next week).

Once we receive the signed MOU back from the school, we can release materials and advise Amanda she is good to go in regards to connecting and coming out to the school.

Re: Unitec-Secondary School delivery of STAR funded programmes across all pathways

Thank you for your continued partnership with Unitec and the opportunities this brings for our young people in our communities. As we continue to look at how we improve our process to better serve you, we have undertaken evaluations across our suite of secondary to tertiary activity based on internal and external stakeholder feedback.

Unitec has recently done an audit check on the Unitec-STAR funded programmes and have found the following issues:

1. Delivery of expired standards and use of expired assessments
2. Reporting against Unitec without an MOU in place
3. Failing to advise Unitec in August of each year of their intent to deliver the following year: 5.1 (j) 'By 31 August each year send to Unitec a Letter of Intent setting out the Courses which the School is intending to provide in the **next** following calendar year
4. Failing to send Unitec copies final student results for our records: 5.1 (m) 'Ensure that the Teacher of each Course marks all tests and assignments in accordance with Unitec's requirements and accreditation then forwards the results to Unitec within 15 days after the completion of the Course'

In response to these compliance issues with the STAR delivery, the following is required:

Remediation actions:

1. All secondary schools are to immediately dispose of any assessment materials they have obtained from Unitec to ensure they do not use moving forward
2. All secondary schools intending on delivering under Unitec in 2020 are to send uss@unitec.ac.nz an email responding to this correspondence, confirming their intent to deliver for 2020 and include the list of standards they wish deliver to their students, while a small number of you have done this, I would appreciate everyone completing this process so we have a full auditable trail and consistent approach
3. Unitec will then respond to confirm the ability to deliver these standards and include with this the correct version numbers to be used
4. Unitec will then create the 2020 MOU for each school, including in this the standards and version numbers and once these MOU are received back from each secondary school, we will release directly from the Unitec Pathways College email, the resources able to be used for 2020

Consequences of the above steps not being taken:

Any secondary school that does not follow the above process will be blocked from reporting under the Unitec provider code from January 31st 2020.

Whilst we appreciate and acknowledge that many of our schools have experienced frustrations with changes to Unitec process (enrolments) and removal of access to Moodle, the above compliance will assist in a more streamlined, transparent and consistent delivery.
