


Re: Unitec-Secondary School delivery of STAR funded programmes across all pathways

Thank you for your continued partnership with Unitee and the opportunities this brings for our young people in our communities. As we continue to look at how we improve our process to better serve you, we have undertaken evaluations across our suite of secondary to tertiary activity based on internal and external stakeholder feedback.

Unitec has recently done an audit check on the Unitec-STAR funded programmes and have found the following issues:

- 1. Delivery of expired standards and use of expired assessments
 2. Reporting against Unitee without an MOUI in place
 3. Reporting against Unitee without an MOUI in place
 3. Failing to see Unitee in August of each year of their intent to deliver the following year: 5.1 (j) To 3.1 August each year send to Unitee a Letter of Intent setting out the Course which the School is intending to provide in the next following calendar year
 4. Failing to send Unitee copies final student results for our records: 5.1 (m) "Ensure that the teacher of each Course marks all tests and assignments in accordance with Unitee's requirements and accreditation thenforwards the results to Unitee within 15 days after the complete

- All secondary schools are to immediately dispose of any assessment materials they have obtained from Unites to ensure they do not use moving forward.
 All secondary schools intending on delivering under United in 2002 are to send <u>purificulties</u>, co.g., an email responding to this correspondance, confirmin appreciate everyone completing this process to we have a full auditable that and consistent approach.
 3. United with their respond to confirm the ability to deliver these standards and include with this the correct version numbers to be used.

Consequences of the above steps not being taken:

Any secondary school that does not follow the above process will be blocked from reporting under the Unitee provider code from January 31st 2020.

Whilst we appreciate and acknowledge that many of our schools have experienced frustrations with changes to Unitee process (enrolments) and removal of access to Moodle, the above compliance will assist in a more streamlined, transparent and consistent delivery
