# 3.2. Institutional Summary of Student Course Survey

Presenter/s: Maura Kempin; Simon Tries

Ako Ahimura celebrated the above-target and highest-ever rating of 8.1 out of 10, and noted that the next Survey is set to go out on 2020-10-12, a little earlier than previous practices to better consider student workload and responsivity to the Survey. Discussion included how response rates have been affected by the Lockdowns, learners completing the survey in class time and the value of the survey from a learner viewpoint. Suggestion was given that future response rates could be improved by implementing a previous institutional practice of PAQCs using a set of criteria to select specific courses for surveying each semester, ensuring that each teacher has at least one course being surveyed.

#### **MOTION**

That Ako Ahimura receive the results of the Survey and recommend that for any course achieving a score of 5 or less, the Chair of Ako Ahimura request the relevant Heads of School to oversee the development of action plans for improvement, seeking support from various departments as needed, e.g. Te Puna Ako. These action plans are to be reported into their Course Evaluation & Planning Reports for Semester 2, 2020 and Programme Evaluation & Planning Reports for 2020 (Interim and End-of-Year).
