- The Postgraduate Scholarship **Guidelines** were reviewed by Assoc Prof Helen Gremillion and Hamza Qazi. Amended guidelines were shared with the committee for approval.

- The recommended changes to the guidelines were accepted by the committee except the following
  - Scholarship payments toward student's fees. Rather the students can opt for this option. Furthermore, the scholarships will only be allocated once the proof of enrolments and payments of fees has been provided.
- The Committee decided to include the following clause in the guidelines.
  - The student can opt for the scholarship payment towards the student's fees for the semester immediately after the Scholarship is awarded. Any scholarship funds remaining after fee payment, for a given student, will be deposited to the student's allocated bank account.
- The Postgraduate Scholarship **Application Forms** were reviewed by Assoc Prof Marcus Williams, Assoc Prof Helen Gremillion, Asma Munir and Hamza Qazi. A new online postgraduate scholarship application form was then prepared by Asma Munir, which was shared with the committee separately for feedback. The form was shared with the committee to discuss the feedback received and approval for the use of the form for the upcoming Scholarship round.
