Based on an extensive self-review process for 2020 and the 2019 improvement plan, Unitec has made significant improvements in striving for excellence. Comparison with the 2019 Summary report illustrates that a lot of work has gone into a number of different outcome areas to move ratings from **good to excellent**.

Unitec is confident in a number of different areas that performance is very strong, processes are effective, there are few to no gaps and where there are gaps the impact on students is minimal. There are some outcome areas that have retained their "good" rating and have made significant improvements to outcomes; improvement plans for these areas will take place in the last quarter of 2020.
