
# **NEWS**

Our Modern Earth (Is A F\*cking Mess) is a new installation and dance-theatre work created by 2016 United acting grad **Amber Liberté** - a topical piece on one of the greatest threats to mankind - climate change. Earth. 4.543 billion years old.



Throughout that time, our planet has shifted, and now we face potential mass extinction. Using recycled materials, Amber will explore how borders of countries have changed over the thousands of years we've inhabited them - and the absurdity of land possession. Each night, a different performer or performers will be given provocations about climate change to create and perform a work right in front of you. Our Modern Earth (Is A F\*cking Mess) runs from 20-24 October at The Basement Theatre, Auckland CBD. Book tickets here.

Last week the School of Creative Industries and GALLERY ONE opened a new exhibition *Kia whakatōmuri te haere whakamua* curated by Master of Creative Practice student, **Tyrone Te Waa**. The selected works span time and space, celebrating the diversity and commonalities shared across art and design practice as a means of navigating a way forward. This group exhibition brings together Unitec's Design and Contemporary Arts Māori students and alumni as a way to uphold the values of this whakataukī. Following the exhibition's opening last Wednesday, an artists' talk took place in the gallery space yesterday on Sunday, 18 October. The exhibition runs until November 6 at Gallery One, Building 76.


