Recommendation

Purpose

The purpose of this paper is to report on work undertaken by Te Komiti Whakamana Hotaka Hou at its 11 November hui.

Commentary

Te Komiti Whakamana Hotaka Hou met to reflect on the work of the committee of the year. No applications were considered at this hui.

The Committee self-assessment covered all aspects of the committee's work. In summary:

- Committee processes were generally sound, however:
 - The documentation which supports these processes could be improved
 - Processes were not always consistently followed.
- Applications received were considered to be of variable quality:
 - o Documentation was at times inconsistent
 - Evidence to support applications was not always sufficient (i.e., evidence of consultation)
- Application outcomes were generally positive, however:
 - Consideration needed to be given to how the institute determines whether applications as approved were successfully implemented (outside of scope of committee)
 - Clarity of approach / conditions for "subject to..." endorsement was required
- Membership
 - o Attendance and participation by some was an issue
 - The importance of members from all schools was noted as this allowed for sharing of good practice and a conduit back to the school on the requirements relating to programme approval
