Lecturer **Bobby Hung** has a book launch for a new 92-page illustration publication he created through the Auckland Libraries with the support of the Research Dissemination Funds. This publication presents a culmination of 80 analogue illustrations created between 2014-2020 by Hung who recently completed his PhD. His thesis was Hitting the street: The legitimation of street art in visual arts education in New Zealand. He explores four key themes that include contemporary visual culture, mythologies and identity, social activism, and graffiti writing. Spanning over six years, each series represent different periods of his life. The launch will be held at the
