Emma Smith, Senior Lecturer in Contemporary Art, was awarded the award for Excellence in Teaching at the Unitec Excellence Awards held on Thursday 3

December. Emma teaches into the Bachelor of Creative Enterprise, supervises on the Master of Creative Practice, and is Discipline Leader for Contemporary Art. The award citation noted that: Emma makes a huge and ongoing contribution to the School, to students and to the broader Unitec environment. She has led the team teaching our contemporary arts students who have had major successes in the Eden Arts' Art Schools Awards in 2019 and 2020. She shows tremendous concern and care for all her students. In a survey, one student commented: "I was blown away by Emma Smith. She



didn't just go to the library and look up books related to my practice, she had read them all then and gave me thorough feedback on the related readings... though she hasn't been teaching me this semester she has found time for me for critiques, and often checks in to see how I'm coping." As well as her teaching and leadership, Emma is a highly-regarded artist, and her work has recently been exhibited at SANC Gallery (Auckland) and Malcolm Smith Gallery, Uxbridge.
