Unitec acting alumnus **Eli Matthewson** (pictured) has won the FRED award for best show at this year's New Zealand International Comedy Festival. The award presented last night at Auckland's SkyCity Theatre is named in honour of much-loved comedy icon John Clarke's legendary Kiwi character Fred Dagg. Eli received the iconic Golden Gumboot and a prize package which included a cash grant of \$2,000 from the New Zealand Comedy Trust. Critics chose Eli out of the more than 40 performers. Unitec alumnae **Laura Daniel**, who graduated with Eli in 2012 was one

Unitec's Year 3 acting students have been divided into three companies who will perform in three separate productions in Auckland in June/July 2021: the first company is working with director Julia Croft on a work to be performed at Unitec (B202) from 30 June-3 July (tickets on sale soon); the second company will



perform with the Auckland Theatre Company on <u>The Life of</u> Galileo from 22



June-10 July; and the third company is with Tim Bray Theatre Company performing in Vivaldi's *The Four Seasons* at The Pumphouse Theatre from 3-17 July.
