This is to inform you of the current Health and Safety issues we are all challenged with and also contains some information to ensure we are all fulfilling our duties of looking after our people.

COVID-19: Alert Level 1

The virus is currently contained in New Zealand, but the worldwide pandemic is not over. Some of the rules we followed in previous alert levels are now no longer in effect, such as physical distancing, but we are still required to stay home if unwell and to contact trace. Please continue to use the Unitec contact tracing app. When on campus and continue to follow good hygiene practices.



Becoming Aware of Slips, Trips, and Falls

Did you know that slips, trips, and falls are the highest causes of injury by far for staff and students at Unitec? There have been 52 incidents recorded in Vault over the past 12 months. **Some examples of risks include**:

- Tripping on an uneven surface, over an obstruction such as exposed cables, or over a wrinkled mat
- Slipping down a stairway and slipping over on a wet surface
- Poor lighting

Some examples of controls we have in place include:

- Signage such as 'Use the handrail' in place on all stairways
- Lighting ensuring there is adequate lighting
- Spills management ensuring that all spills are cleaned up immediately
- Hazard ID reporting all Near Misses into Vault

Tips:

- Take your time and pay attention to where you are walking be aware of your surroundings
- Use handrails on stairs
- Wear appropriate footwear and adjust your stride to a pace that is suitable for the walking surface
- Ensure that things you are carrying or pushing do not prevent you from seeing any obstruction, such as spills
