Unitec Master of Creative Practice student **Tyrone Te Waa** had two new exhibitions open over the past weekend.



graduating with a post-graduate diploma, creative practice in 2021, she was selected by Auckland Unlimited to make a mural celebrating the diversity of Auckland in the CBD.

Three United alumni were among the finalists selected for the Storieroad International program being offered by Script to Screen in partnership with US-based Catalyst Story Institute. Jake Pitcher (Don't Tell Mum), Millen Baird (Darryl) were both finalists alongside former Screen Arts lecturer, Maile Daugherty (Serenade) - picture right - while **Kip Chapman** (*Public* Affairs) and a second work by **Millen Baird** (Naki Blues) were semi-finalists. Storieroad International program is focused on discovering content creators and advancing creative careers within the global episodic marketplace. Applicants had to be developing a series of any genre, length or format and at any stage of development. The finalists get a 12-month scholarship where they get USbased industry support to progress their project. More here.
