Note

1. Rakesh Patel reply can be summaries as the ENR courses that are part of PBRF courses are excluded from EPI reporting. This also means that ENR courses that are not part of PBRF courses are currently included in the EPI reporting. Thus for ENR courses of less than 90 credits, Rakesh will need to investigate further as to how the reporting of such ENR courses can be improved such that it does not negatively impact the overall EPI data.

ACTION: Assoc Prof Marcus Williams to follow up in July with Rakesh Patel regarding the update on the task related to resolving the issue of sub-90 credits ENR courses EPI reporting.

The feedback from members was received and is incorporated into the attached spreadsheet. The leaders of each Level 9 & 10 programme affirm that the information is accurate.


