# 3.1 Te Komiti Whakahaere a ngā Pia / Postgraduate Research and Scholarships Committee Membership, Meeting Dates, Terms of Reference and Work Plan for 2022

Helen Gremillion requested the Chair to consider the Terms of Reference on examination and grade processing work for level 9 sub 90 credits seeing that the Terms of Reference are incompatible with the Masters Generic Regulations.

The Chair acknowledged that there is an anomaly in the regulations which will require attention and reiterated that the Committee was only approving the Terms of Reference and not the regulations.

Members recommended the following two items for the Workplan:

- 1. In February and August, an update from the Chair, Annabel Pretty and Matthew Bradbury on Te Pūkenga regarding progress around postgraduate discussions of the future of postgraduate study
- 2. In May, an update from Dr. Hinekura Smith on Kaupapa Maori research with emphasis on student satisfaction.
