



Windows 10 Self Service Upgrade



Install instructions

The Windows 10 update provides the latest security and standard application updates. Before you start the update, note the following:


- · Save and close any open files before you begin the update
- If you have any files (documents, images, etc.) saved to your Desktop or on your local drive, you will need to keep these in your shared drive or OneDrive if you don't, you could lose these files during the update process
- Do not access or shut down your computer once the update process is underway leave it to run until it is complete, and the login screen displays
- During the update the process, your computer will reboot several times this
 doesn't mean it's finished wait for the login screen to pop up then you can log
 back on

Steps to install the update:

1. Go to your Desktop and open Software Centre




2. Click on Operating Systems








3. Click on Install




4. Click Install once more







5. Once the installation starts, you can lock your computer while the installation is running – click on **Ctrl+Alt+Del** and select **Lock**
