Eliqibility Criteria:

- Enrolled or intending to enroll in a full-time or part-time United Masters Programme
- Committed to completing a research thesis of at least 90 credits
- Minimum average grade as given below or equivalent in all previous study at Level 7 or above;
 a. minimum grade of B+ for Programme Base scholarships
 - b. minimum grade of B for Māori and Pacific scholarships
- Provisional grades can be used to calculate the GPA if necessary.
- International students are eligible to apply if they meet all the above criteria.
- Full-time Unitec staff are not eligible to apply.

Applications for these scholarships open in September/October 2022 and close in January/February 2023.
