
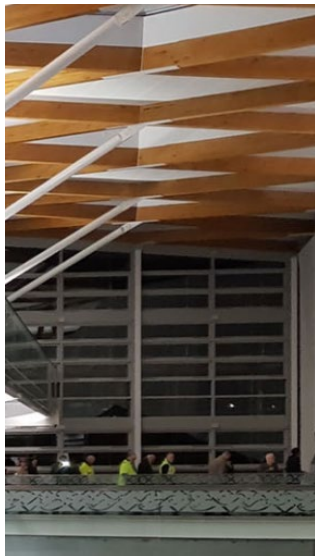


**Multifactor authentication has been enabled when accessing theNest externally.**

You will need to enter you staff Unitec email address and then you will be redirected to the Unitec login page where you will enter your password.



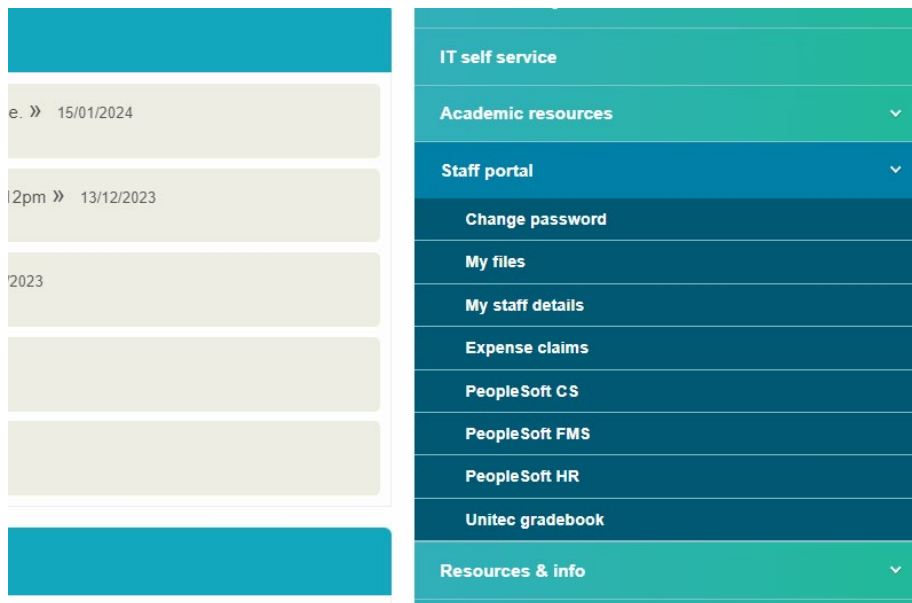
