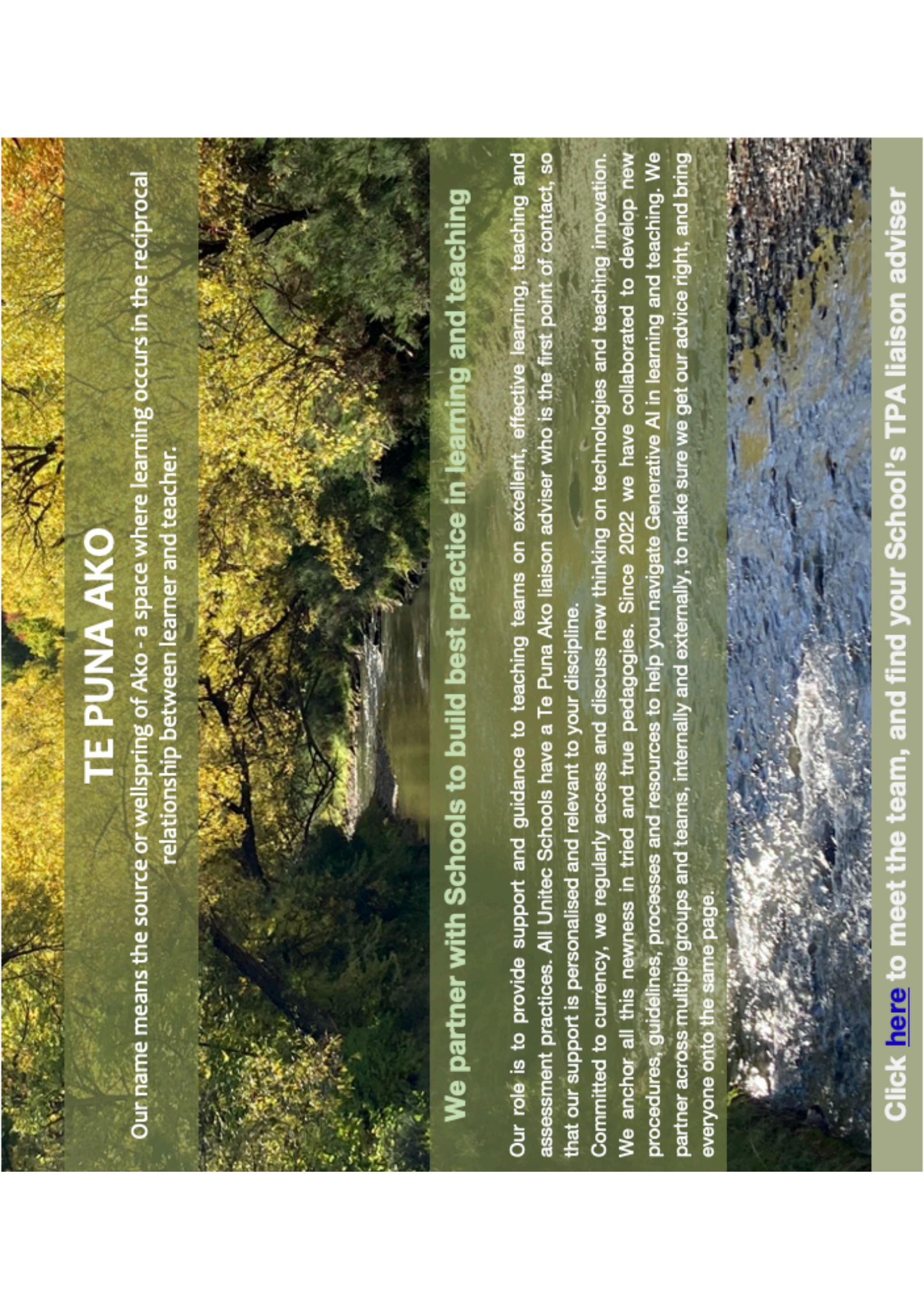




TE PUNA AKO
