Saturday 31 August, 9:00am-2:30pm

Open Day is a one-stop shop of our offerings to prospective students. Approximately 1000 prospects and their influencers (whānau and friends) in attendance.

Attendees can talk to lecturers and school advisors in their area of interest, giving them all the information they need to make an informed decision about studying at Unitec. Support and enrolment services are also available on the day.

Objectives

- Maximise awareness and lift consideration for prospective students.
- Engage and interact with academic staff, support personnel and current students.

How

- **Greater Access** Open Saturday, estimated 500 to 1000 attendees, scheduled tours around Te Puna, as well as school-specific tours of labs and study spaces.
- **More Targeted** Tailored school promotions, geo-targeted digitally driven media campaign supported with radio, digital and social media campaigns.
- **More Support** Trained ambassadors and staff to give directions and answer questions. Student Central will be open to process applications, Student Success will be available to provide answers on student support services.
- **Improved Experience** Smooth registration, personalised guides, activation plans and engaging activities.

Leveraging Unitec's Buildings

Open Day is an opportunity to experience what it's like to be a student in Unitec's spaces - Te Puna, Mataaho, Building 108 and Waitākere campus. This is the public's opportunity to explore their future classrooms, workshop spaces, and common areas. 




Mt Albert Campus Floor Plan

Registration before the day

Guests register for the day before they arrive on www.unitec.ac.nz/openday. When they register, they receive an email with a 6-digit code for the event. They are asked to bring this with them on the day, which is scanned into a form on iPads when they arrive to confirm their attendance. This will support our ability to follow-up and track their progress after Open Day.

Registration on the day

If a guest has not registered beforehand, they will be able to register by typing in their details on the iPad registration forms. Once they put in their details and submit, they will receive an email.

Transport Between Campuses

We will have shuttle bus running between the two campuses every 45 mins.

Services

Applications

We will be having SEMs at each of the stands and Student Central will be open throughout the day to assist with application, programme advice, and field any other questions about studying at Unitec. Student Central will be open at Te Puna and Waitākere.

Student Support Services

Student Central and our Programme Advisors will be available to answer any questions about our support services at both campuses.

The Funding Your Studies team, Access4Success and Career Development team will have their own stands this year to give advice on how to make their goals a realty and to make the process of applying easier.

Bridging Education

Bridging Education will have a stand set up in each Open Day location, ready to take quests through how they can prepare for their studies.

Everyone, regardless of your role, will have a hand in dealing with queries around Unitec and Open Day, so you will still need an understanding of what we're delivering on the day.

Familiarise yourself with the maps, locations of the study disciplines, and scheduled shuttle busses between the two campuses.

Registration Team

When guests come to the desk, greet them and ask if they have preregistered. If they have, ask them to bring up the email confirmation from United with the ticket code. Put in the 6-digit code and let them in.

If they haven't registered yet, send them across to the Walk-in registration team, who will register them with walk-in webform.

Hand over their goodie bag (contained coffee voucher) and point out where it may be used (Long Black Cafe).

Finally, point them in the direction of our Guides for any further questions, so you can move on to the next person.

Guide

After the guest has registered, it's your responsibility to guide them based on their needs. You may need to escort them to the specific area or discipline they wish to visit.

When escorting guests, engage them in conversation. Ask about their current situation—whether they're in school or working, and where. Inquire about the study area they're interested in and what appeals to them about it. Encourage them to ask our lecturers any questions they might have!

Help them figure out what to look at first if they are interested in more than one area - point them in the direction of the things closest together, so they are not going back and forth all day.

Encourage them to look for the team in the United shirts if they have any questions.

For All Schools

Programme Advisors

This role is much like the Student Recruitment Advisor role, primarily your role will be to support the academics and have more in-depth discussions with prospective students around courses and Unitec's offerings. Keep one prospectus on you that you can use as a reference for your conversations.

The SEMs will have laptops with them and will be located near every stand to help with enrolment. Student Ambassadors can support the Programme Advisors with helping the guest through their application, so the Programme Advisor can move on to helping others.

Schools Coordinators

You have a multi-faced role of being the first point of contact for the guests as they arrive in each location, coordinate the team of guides and be the 'go to' person for our academic staff. This will include re-stocking brochures, answering FAQs on Open Day activities, tours, shuttles, applications, student support services, and staff catering.

Activity Coordinators

Your role is to ensure the activities run on time and the right people are in the right place from the different schools to deliver these activities.
